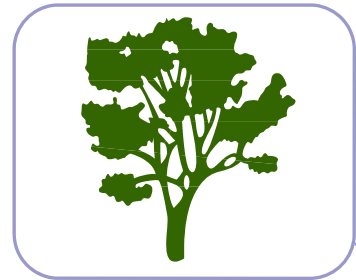
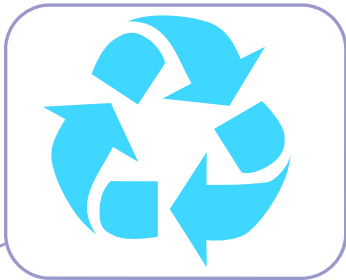


# Great Summer Opportunity for High School Students!
